Impact of Instructional Domains

The information below represents outcomes associated with children ages 3 to 5 who completed their developmental assessment.

Approaches to Learning - involves initiative, curiosity and problem solving. Out of 1,663 children, 84.49% mastered this knowledge.

Creative Arts - involves music, art and dramatic play. Out of 1,677 children, 85.39% mastered this knowledge area.

Early Math – involves numbers, spatial sense and patterns. Out of 1,652 children, 78.39% mastered this knowledge area.

Fine and Gross Motor Development – involves fine and gross motor skills. Out of 1,571, 78.87% mastered this knowledge area.

Language and Literacy – involves listening, understanding, speaking, communicating, phonological awareness, book knowledge/appreciation, print awareness/concepts, early writing and alphabet knowledge. Out of 1,581 children, 81.9% mastered this knowledge area.

Nature and Science- involves skills/methods, scientific knowledge. Out of 1,497 children, 73.01% mastered this knowledge area.

Physical Health Practices – involves health status and practices. Out of 1,541 children, 78.13% mastered this knowledge area.

Social and Emotional Development – involves self-concept, self-control and cooperation. Out of 1,515 children, 73.98% mastered this knowledge Area.

This assessment is completed on all 4 years old children who were scheduled to begin kindergarten in 2006-2007.
